

Metal Finisher I

Position Purpose

To operate plating and cleaning processes in the department efficiently.

Requirements

- ❑ Requires above average physical exertion. Must be able to work wearing a respirator if required, and must be physically able to tolerate extreme heat.
- ❑ Must be able to work with chemicals in the plating process.
- ❑ Requires good visual acuity.
- ❑ Must be able to stand for up to 12 hours.
- ❑ Must be able to lift 40 lbs frequently, and up to 50 lbs occasionally.
- ❑ Must be able to work varying hours and in varying conditions.
- ❑ Must be a high school graduate or GED, and must be able to read, write, and be proficient in basic arithmetic skills.
- ❑ May be required to use hearing protection and participate in hearing conservation program.
- ❑ May be required to participate in Confined Space Entry training program and take corresponding physical examination.
- ❑ Must successfully complete an initial program of classroom instruction regarding the nature of handling, storage, and treatment of hazardous material including all pertinent regulations. Continuing on the job training will be done when deemed necessary by Supervisor or when new materials or regulations are introduced. This training must include emergency response procedures including shutdown of operations.
- ❑ Occasional use of pallet jacks and drum dollies may be required.

Hazardous Waste Management

May be responsible for managing hazardous waste at the point of generation in accordance with generator waste accumulation requirements. Responsible for following procedures in the Wright & McGill Preparedness, Prevention, and Contingency plan.
